 Agility Courses Descriptions

Young Dog Agility	Agility Level 1 (A-1)
<p>Prerequisites: <i>Puppy Kindergarten, and either Puppy Kindergarten II or Obedience I. The dog should be between 6-12 months old or have permission of an agility instructor.</i></p> <p>Length: 6 weeks</p> <p>Tuition: \$100.00</p> <p>Young Dog Agility is a great way to expose your young dog to the fun of Agility and to ‘burn’ off some extra energy. The class focuses on showing your puppy the ‘ropes’ of the teeter, jumps, weave poles and other agility obstacles – at a easy level.</p> 	<p>Prerequisites: <i>Obedience I. Dog must be a minimum of 12 months old or have permission of an agility instructor</i></p> <p>Length: 6 weeks</p> <p>Tuition: \$100.00</p> <p>You and your dog learn the agility obstacle equipment, agility ring etiquette and safety in the ring. Starting with jumps, you train as a team to gain confidence in moving over, up or through an obstacle. You learn jumps, weave poles, teeter, dog walk, A-frame, tunnel, pause table and chute (collapsed tunnel).</p> 
Agility Level 2 (A-2)	Agility Level 3 (A-3)
<p>Prerequisites: <i>Agility Level 1</i></p> <p>Length: 6 weeks</p> <p>Tuition: \$100.00</p> <p>Refine your dog’s skill on obstacles and begin focusing on basic handling techniques. Each week will focus one or two handling techniques for the first half of the class. A course will be set up for the second half of the class to incorporate the training into a full run. You strengthen your ‘get-out’ and ‘here’ commands, learn front and rear crosses, various weave pole entries, running your dog on your left AND right sides, handling traps and much more.</p> 	<p>Prerequisites: <i>Agility Level 2</i></p> <p>Length: 6 weeks.</p> <p>Tuition: \$100.00</p> <p>A-III brings you and your dog to a higher level of teamwork. You focus on advanced handling techniques and agility course work that varies from Novice Level to Expert Level. By the time you reach A-III, your dog should be competent on most obstacles (weave poles are an exception) and you work on improving your skills in directing your dog and efficiently running agility courses.</p> 
AllBreed Agility Run Club (ABARC)	
<p>Prerequisites: <i>Agility Level 2 or have permission of agility instructor</i></p> <p>Length: <i>On Going</i></p> <p>Tuition: <i>\$10.00 per week or \$50 for a 6 week punch card</i></p> <p>AllBreed Agility Run Club (ABARC) combines open practice time and course practice runs. The first 30 minutes is open practice for you and your dog – you can work on specific obstacles or skills that you want to perfect as a team. The last 30 minutes is course running practice</p>
